One grant of \$2000.00 will be given to the applicant who is able to most clearly demonstrate how this award will aid in their mission to assist children in need.

Proposals should be kept to 2-5 pages. Please be sure to include the following in your proposal:

- Name of your organization
- Where your organization is located
- Your organization's mission statement
- Average age of population you serve
- The type of services you provide
- A brief description of the way in which the award will be used to service your mission
- Award Distribution Budget Plan
- Timeline for services
- Number of children you anticipate assisting with these funds
- Expected outcomes

Total Award Amount: \$2000.00

Evaluation Criteria: Students in the Justice Advocacy class will be evaluating proposals on an individual basis. Preference will be given to applicants who are able to begin incorporating the award into their service initiatives by Monday, April 6, 2015.
